The City of Ontario invites bids for the construction of the SW 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue Sanitary Sewer Extension 2010-1.

This work consists of construction of approximately 805 lineal feet of 8-inch diameter sanitary sewer main including pipe, manholes, service laterals and surface restoration at the location identified above.

Sealed bids for the described project will be received by the Public Works Director, or an authorized representative of the City of Ontario at the City of Ontario Public Works Department, 444 SW 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Ontario, Oregon 97914, until 2 p.m. Mountain Time, Wednesday, August 4, 2010. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the same location at 2:15 p.m. Mountain Time Wednesday, August 4, 2010.

Each bid on the project shall be submitted on the prescribed form, along with a bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid amount, including any alternates and addendums, if required. Upon bid award, the successful bidder will promptly execute the Contract, secure payment of Workmen's Compensation Insurance, and furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the total bid price and a Payment Bond in the amount of one-hundred percent (100%) of the total bid price. Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked "Bid for the City of Ontario, Oregon, SW 4<sup>TH</sup> Avenue Sanitary Sewer Extension 2010-1," and show the name and business address of the bidder.

The Contract shall be subject to the applicable provisions of ORS 279.348 through ORS 279.380, the Oregon Prevailing Wage Law. All prospective bidders and their subcontractors shall be actively registered with the State of Oregon Construction Contractor's Board.

Contractor shall provide his/her mailing address, phone and fax numbers when plans are requested. Contract Documents will be available by email

Contractor shall complete all Work as specified or indicated in the contract documents. Contractor shall comply with the general conditions of the Idaho Specifications for Public Works Construction (ISPWC) 2010 Edition and the Ontario Supplemental Standards dated March 2008.

The work is generally described as follows:

The contractor shall provide all products, materials, labor and equipment for the construction of a sewer main extension in SW 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue in accordance with the intent of the Technical Specification. Work includes traffic control, and any other related work required to complete this project.

The work will be completed in all respects within 30 calendar days from the date of Notice to Proceed.

Bidder shall be qualified in accordance with the applicable parts of ORS 279C.430 to ORS 279C.450 in order to submit a bid for public work in Oregon.

Bidders shall submit a statement identifying whether the bidder is a resident bidder as defined in ORS 279A.120.

No bid will be received or considered by Owner unless the Bid contains, or is accompanied by a statement by the bidder as a part of the bid that the provisions required by ORS 279C.840 pertaining to prevailing wages shall be included in the agreement.

City of Ontario reserves the right to reject any or all bids in accordance with ORS 279B.100 or any bid not conforming to the intent and purpose of the bidding documents.
